



JUSTICE FISHER.

GEO. W. FISHER, eldest son of George Fisher, was born in New York in 1865. In 1866, the family moved to Staten Island and settled in the town of Middletown. In 1884, they purchased the farm near New Springville, where the family have since resided.

In 1892, Mr. Fisher was elected justice of the peace for the town of Northfield, and is probably the youngest justice in Richmond county, but his decisions have been marked by an impartiality and legal knowledge which have won for him the confidence and respect, even of his opponents.

In 1890, Mr. Fisher married Miss Mary Miller of New Springville. They have two children, Walter Irving, aged two years, and Ethel, aged one year.
