CHARLES LIVINGSTON HUBBELL, son of Charles Wolcott Hubbell and Serena Hempsted, his wife, was born in Brooklyn, New York, July 14th, 1861. His great-grandfather, Philip Livingston, was one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence, and was a descendant of the Livingston family of Livingston Manor, New York, prominent in the early history of New York state.

Mr. Hubbell is descended on his father's side from Richard Hubbell, who came from Wales in 1645 and settled in Connecticut, and whose descendants were prominent officers in the revolutionary war, the war of 1812 and in the civil war.

Mr. Hubbell came to Staten Island when a boy of six years of age, and, after finishing an academic education, engaged in business for a few years, and then entered the law office of Hon. Frank Warner Angel, asst. United States district attorney, and commenced the study of law. He then attended the law school of New York University and was graduated in the class of '86, admitted to the bar May 12th, 1887, and entered into the practice of his profession with offices in New York city and on Staten Island.

Taking great interest in the development and prosperity of Staten Island, Mr. Hubbell formed the Granite Park Land and Improvement Company, of which he is president and counsel. He is also vice-regent of Staten Island Council, 1145, Royal Arcanum, charter member of Starin Hose Company, No. 5, of West New Brighton, charter member of the Republican Spellbinder Club of New York city, one of the founders of New York University Law Department Alumni Association, and member of the Irving Literary Society, which defeated all the famous and well-known debating societies in New York city and Brooklyn.

In addition, the popular and busy lawyer stumped the state for Harrison and Morton during that memorable campaign, and is active in politics and all that appertains to the welfare and prosperity of Richmond county.

He was married January 4th, 1893, to Eleanor Mathews Beach, and resides at West New Brighton, at which place he is engaged in the general practice of law, and has a growing and lucrative practice.
