



COLLECTOR PAUL LATOURETTE.

PAUL LATOURETTE, for many years the tax collector of the town of Northfield, was born at Summerville, S. I., August 11th, 1830, and belongs to the old Latourette family which settled on Staten Island nearly two centuries ago.

In his early life, Mr. Latourette followed the water and was an oyster planter on a large scale.

He was collector for the town of Northfield in 1883 and has held the office continuously since that time, except that he refuses the nomination every third year.
